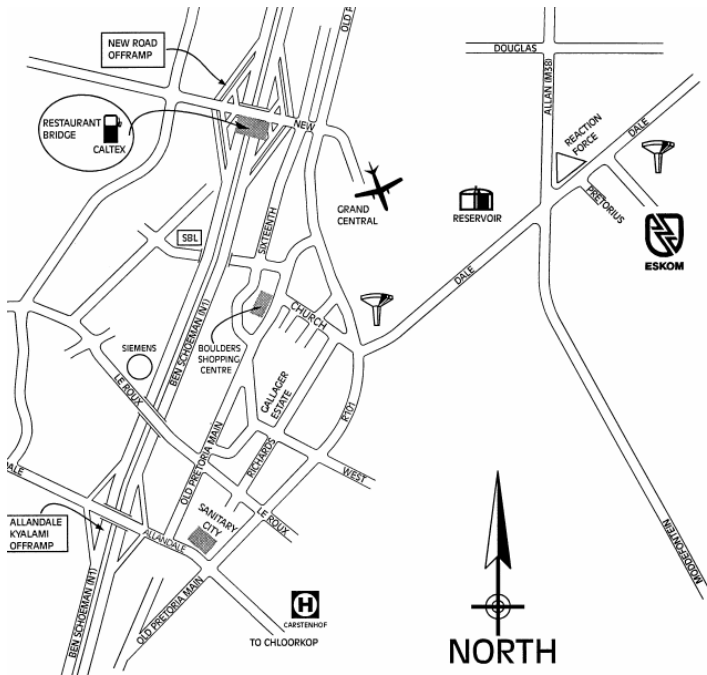


DIRECTIONS



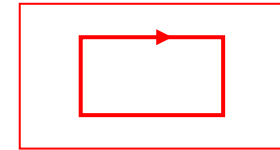
From Sandton/Roodepoort

- Take the Ben Schoeman Highway to Pretoria (N1).
- Take the Allandale Midrand off-ramp.
- Turn right at the traffic lights at the top of the off-ramp (You will be crossing the highway).
- Continue over two traffic lights and turn left at the third traffic light (at Sanitary City) onto the K101 Road (R101 Grand Central/Valhalla sign). Continue straight for 2,7 km (crossing Le Roux and West Roads).
- At the traffic light, turn right into Dale Road and continue straight for 2,1 km.
- Cross a traffic light and continue straight for 0,6 km. The entrance to the Eskom Convention Centre is on your right.

From Pretoria

- Take the Ben Schoeman Highway to Johannesburg (N1).
- Take the Olifantsfontein Road off-ramp.
- Turn right at the top of the off-ramp and continue straight.
- Cross the traffic lights and continue straight.
- At the four-way stop, turn right into Allan Road and continue for approx. 3,7 km.
- At the traffic lights, turn left into Dale road.
- Eskom Convention and Exhibition Centre is 0,6 km down the road, on your right.
